Another MH370 Family Seeks Answers in US Courts

Kelly adds that all responsible parties must be brought to justice. "We must find what caused the aircraft to crash and demand that the problems with the airline and the aircraft's design and manufacturing are immediately resolved to avoid future tragedies."
